- A project in East London to refurbish an existing playground for 6-12 year olds as well as adding small interventions of natural play in the form of a nature trail and a trim trail to connect the wider park area
- The playground is used by the public, a community centre catering for educational needs and needs to be designed to be used by the local schools
- The design was a result of various consultations within the local community and uses "Inclusion by design" principles (published by CABE), to stimulate childrens physical and imaginative play by adding a mixture of natural materials, (including sand and water play), colours, suitable play walls and equipment as well as sensory planting at various heights
- FHApplay have also ensured that wheelchair users can travel along the site and access suitable play equipment
